The **Europe-Cuba Forum** is a European Union-funded Jean Monnet Network initiative comprising 11 leading institutions working together in researching Cuban affairs as well as relations between Europe and Cuba. More information about the network can be found online at:

<http://www.foroeuropacuba.org/>. The Forum’s second conference will bring together distinguished scholars from Cuba and Europe to discuss issues of institutional reform and social policy on the island, with an eye to exploring potential cooperation between Europe and Cuba.

The Europe-Cuba Forum invites papers from early career scholars and **will provide support with travel and accommodation costs** for 4 Europe-based participants (max. EUR 600 per person). Selection of recipients will be made according to academic excellence, and fit to the conference theme. In addition, the best junior researcher paper will receive an **award** of EUR 300 and will be included in the Europe-Cuba Forum’s working papers series. Eligible are docs, post-docs (max. four years after the defence of their thesis, longer in case of parental leave), and advanced master students. Applicants are requested to submit by **no later than 15 February 2020** a one-page summary of their paper, plus a short CV to: foro-europa-cuba-2020@giga-hamburg.de.
